Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent with: Grade 12 English: ENG4(C) or ENG4(U)

OR Mature Student Status (age 19 or older) with the above prerequisite course(s), their equivalent(s) or appropriate Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) Certificate program credits.
